Charlie Maguire, one of America's premiere acoustic folk musicians, has written award-winning songs about the people and places of the upper midwest.

While researching famed WWII photographer Robert Capa, Charlie uncovered a little-known photo essay shot over the course of a year on Donald Pratt's family farm in **Glidden, Iowa**. As one of Capa's few peacetime photo assignments, he documented the family in their home, barn, school, church, and in town. The photos ran in *Ladies Home Journal* throughout 1947. Hear the song Charlie wrote about visiting the Pratt farm along with a selection of ballads about farm and country.
